Speaker 1 Bio: Angela Haun,**Executive Director of the Oil & Natural Gas Information Sharing and Analysis Center (ONG-ISAC)**

On September 1, 2018, Angela Haun became the Executive Director of the Oil and Natural Gas Information Sharing and Analysis Center (ONG-ISAC). Retired FBI Special Agent (SA) Angela Haun brings great experience in cybersecurity and protecting critical assets from her work at the FBI, along with her leadership skills from the Houston InfraGard Chapter, which became the largest in the country while she was the FBI coordinator. Ms Haun was appointed Special Agent of the FBI 20 years ago. She served in the Chicago Division, the Office of Congressional Affairs and the Cyber Division at FBI Headquarters, and the Houston Division. Agent Haun has received numerous awards for her work at the FBI, including the Director's Award for Outstanding Criminal Investigation. In April 2015, Agent Haun received a "Citation for Special Achievement," signed by then FBI Director James Comey, for her dedication and hard work supporting the Houston Members Alliance – one of the most robust InfraGard chapters in the country. Agent Haun received the award for "InfraGard Coordinator of the Year" from the InfraGard National Members Alliance in 2013 and 2016.
